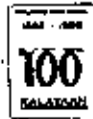



ORDER

On October 10, 2001, this Commission issued a SHOW CAUSE ORDER, directing BRADFORD-KEMPNER MANAGEMENT SERVICES, INC. (Bradford for brevity) to show cause; within fifteen (15) days from receipt thereof, why its certificate of incorporation should not be revoked.

After careful examination of the Petition of the Compliance and Enforcement Department (CED) as well as the documents annexed therewith, we affirm the following findings:

- (1) that the primary purpose of Bradford, stated in its Articles of Incorporation, does not include the business of engaging as broker/dealer.

We quote:

To render management and consultancy services and act as advisers to individuals, partnerships and corporations located outside the Philippines and in this connection conduct research, studies, surveys on the international market for purposes of identifying

prospective investment opportunities; and in the process provide information on economic trends and market developments; produce the relevant research reports and periodicals; promote and assist prospective investors to enter into joint venture agreements in the Philippines; provide venture capital where needed; and provide administrative services such as communications, monitoring, mailing, billing and other clerical and secretarial support in connection therewith.

Nowhere in its purpose can this Commission discern any words that would suggest the terms Broker/Dealer in securities, yet Respondent acted as such by soliciting and offering securities to customers.¹

- (2) a Broker/Dealer in securities needs a secondary license, as required in the Securities Regulation Code, and the Respondent had none². By going beyond its primary purpose and not having a secondary license to be a Broker/Dealer in securities, Bradford **fraudulently and seriously misrepresented** itself to the investing public.

Bradford failed to answer the Show Cause Order within the prescribed period despite receipt thereof by its counsel of record on November 22, 2001.

In view thereof, and in the light of this Commission's affirmation of the findings of the Compliance and Enforcement Department, we find that there is compelling reason to revoke its certificate of registration.

WHEREFORE, pursuant to the authority of the Commission under P.D. 902-A, as amended, and Section 5 (m) of the Securities Regulation Code, the certificate of registration of Bradford-Kempner Management Services, Inc. is hereby REVOKED. Let a copy of this ORDER be furnished to the Company Registration and Monitoring Department so that it may be attached to the corporate records of the subject corporation.


