XTRADE.COM

The Securities and Exchange Commission received information that a Filipino investor accessed and invested money in **XTRADE.COM**. XTRADE.COM is an electronic trading platform in securities such as Contracts for Difference (CFD), Indices, Commodities, Forex, Shares, Exchange Traded Funds and Bonds.

For the information of the general public, **XTRADE.COM** is **NOT REGISTERED** with SEC as a corporation or as a partnership. Further, it has **NO LICENSE** to issue or sell securities in the Philippines, including those mentioned above, as required by Sections 8 and 12 of the Securities Regulation Code.

Consequently, **XTRADE.COM** and its officers, salesmen and agents are **NOT ALLOWED BY LAW** to OFFER and/or SELL securities in the Philippines or to perform any similar acts, whether online or not.
