Notice is hereby given to all concerned that the Commission will be conducting a **two-day Certification Seminar for Prospective Equities Securities Salesmen** on **10-11 September 2019**. The seminar will be held at Banquet Hall 3, 2nd Floor, Secretariat Building, Philippine International Convention Center, Roxas Boulevard, Pasay City.


All interested participants are encouraged to file their accomplished registration forms on or before 5:00 p.m. of Friday, 30 August 2019. 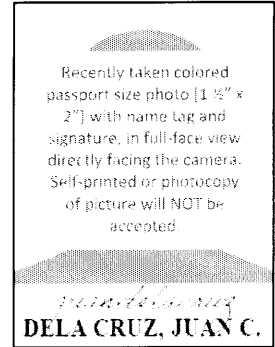
