- Price quotation/s must be valid for a period of thirty (30) calendar days from the date of submission.
- 3. Price quotation/s which shall be in Philippine peso shall include all taxes, duties and/or

### levies payable

- 4. Quotation/s exceeding the Approved Budget for the Contract shall be rejected.
- Award of contract shall be made to the Single/Lowest Calculated and Responsive Quotation (for goods and infrastructure) or, the Highest Rated Quotation (for consulting services).
- Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting shall be valid only of they are signed or initialed by you or any of your duly authorized representative/s.
- The item/s shall be delivered according to the accepted technical proposal and specified in the Notice of Award.
- 8. Brand of the offer, if required, should be indicated as part of the bid. Non-indication of the brand may be considered as ground for disqualification. Sample, if required, shall also be submitted as part of the quotation. Non-submission of sample may be considered as ground for disqualification.
- The SEC shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the goods to confirm their conformity to the technical specifications.
