- 4. Quotation/s exceeding the Approved Budget for the Contract shall be rejected.
- Award of contract shall be made to the Single/Lowest Calculated and Responsive Quotation (for goods and infrastructure) or, the Highest Rated Quotation (for consulting services).
- Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initiated by you or any of your duly authorized representative/s.
- The item/s shall be delivered according to the accepted technical proposal and specified in the Notice of Award.
- 8. Brand of the offer, if required, should be indicated as part of the bid. Non-indication of the brand may be considered as ground for disqualification. Catering Services for the Intermediate Computer Proficiency Learning Program.

2. Objective of the Project

To search, identify and recommend to the Commission En Banc, through the Bids and Awards Committee (SEC-BAC), an appropriate catering service for the conduct of the Intermediate Computer Proficiency Learning Program.

3. Approved Budget for the Contract

The maximum possible contract price for the services for **five (5) days** is **NINETY-THREE THOUSAND PESOS ONLY (PhP 93,000.00)** for a total of **54 participants or 27 participants per batch.**

This amount shall be inclusive of 12% Value Added Tax (VAT) and other taxes imposed by the government.
