- 1. Bidders shall provide correct and accurate information required in this form.
- 2. Price quotation/s must be valid for a period of thirty (30) calendar days from the date of submission
- 3. Price quotation/s which shall be in Philippine peso shall include all taxes, duties and/or levies payable.
- 4. Quotation/s exceeding the Approved Budget for the Contract shall be rejected.
- 5. Award of contract shall be made to the Single/Lowest Calculated and Responsive Quotation (for goods and infrastructure) or, the Highest Rated Quotation (for consulting services).
- 6. Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting shall be valid only of they are signed or initialed by you or any of your duly authorized representative/s.
- 7. The item/s shall be delivered according to the accepted technical proposal and specified in the Notice of Award.
- 8. Brand of the offer, if required, should be indicated as part of the bid. Non-indication of the brand may be considered as ground for disqualification. Sample, if required, shall also be submitted as part of the quotation. Non-submission of sample may be considered as ground for disqualification.
- 9. The SEC shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the goods to confirm their conformity to the technical specifications.
- 10. In case two or more bidders are determined to have submitted the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Quotation, the rules on Tie-Breaking as provided under the existing rules shall be observed to arrive at the LCRQ.
- 11. Payment shall be processed after delivery and upon the submission of the required supporting documents, in accordance with the existing accounting rules and regulations. Please note that the corresponding bank transfer fee, if any, shall be to the contractor's account.
- 12. Liquidated damages equivalent to one tenth of one percent (0.1%) of the value of the goods not delivered within the prescribed delivery period shall be imposed for day of delay. The SEC shall rescind the contract once the commutative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.

VI. MANPOWER REQUIREMENTS

The Supplier shall have a manpower that is properly and fully qualified to perform the class of work provided herein, and that all are authorized, properly trained, equipped, organized and financed to perform such work.

VIII. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Service Provider shall be held liable for any losses or damages during the loading, transport and unloading of goods, proven that it is due to the company's negligence.
- 2. All necessary clearance/permits, coordination and their corresponding fees shall be borne with the Service Provider (ie. Truck Ban Exemption or Travel Clearance between Local Government Units (LGU's) of Makati, and Mandaluyong and all other similar requirements needed for the project.
- 3. Bid Price includes expenses in fuel, 1 driver,1 helper fee, parking fees, toll fees and other applicable fees and taxes. No hidden fees.
- 4. Schedule of trip shall be done 2 to 3 days prior to the actual date of delivery,
- 5. Terms of Payment:
 - Supplier can partial bill once 10 trips are completed or 100% payment shall be made on the end of the contract and billing shall be based on the actual number of trips made not to exceed the estimated number of trips (30). Actual Trips shall be properly documented with accomplishment reports submitted to HRAD-GSD and certified by the HRAD Director or his/her duly authorized representative.
 - b. Payment is subject to applicable taxes.
 - c. When the Supplier fails to satisfactorily deliver goods within the specified delivery schedule, inclusive of duly granted time extensions, if any the Supplier shall be liable for damages for the delay and shall pay the procuring entity liquidated damages an amount equal to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the delayed goods scheduled for delivery, for every day of delay until such goods are finally delivered and accepted the procuring entity concerned.
