



SEC ADVISORY

The Commission has received information that individuals or group of persons representing **UNITYNET CORPORATION** (“**UNITYNET**”) are enticing the public to invest in the said entity online or through the internet.

Based on the information communicated and gathered by the Commission, **UNITYNET**, headed by **Eduard Gary Salazar Reformina**, allegedly sells the so-called “**Ascending Profit System**” (**APS**), an online automated system containing the following materials:

1. 10 Steps Training Kit (allegedly worth P10,000.00);
2. 1 on 1 Coaching (allegedly worth P10,000.00);
3. Done for Your System (allegedly worth P20,000.00);
4. Payment and Fulfilment System (allegedly worth P10,000.00);
5. Sales Team (allegedly worth P10,000.00); and
6. 30-Day Traffic Implementation Program or T.I.P. (allegedly worth P10,000.00).

Under the APS, members are allegedly trained on how to recruit or sponsor more downlines into his/her network marketing business, how one could sell products online effectively, and how one could promote his/her traditional business. Instead of paying the total amount of Php70,000.00, the APS can be availed of for only **Two Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Pesos (Php2,990.00)**.

UNITYNET CORPORATION claims that a member will earn P1,000.00 for every person he refers into the system. Likewise, the prospective investor is told that he can earn as much as P11,000.00 but he must join **UNITYNET** right away because **ONLY LIMITED** slots are available.

A member may recruit by posting on his/her social media account or website, an inspirational video that has an enticing clickable banner (e.g. *Gusto mo bang kumita ng extrang P10,000.00?*) which when clicked, shall redirect the prospective member to a referral link leading to the video presentation of **UNITYNET** and finally ending up to their sign-up page that is modified to link to the referrer’s **UNITYNET** account. The referrer’s unique code is indicated in the link and shall serve automatically as the new investor’s sponsor that is entitled to the commission/referral income.

The public is hereby informed that although **UNITYNET CORPORATION** is registered with the Commission as a corporation, however, such primary registration merely confers upon the entity a juridical personality under the Corporation Code of the Philippines and does **NOT** authorize it to offer, solicit, sell or distribute any investment/securities. Such activities require a Secondary License from the Commission and the securities or investment product should likewise be registered with SEC before they can be offered or sold to the public under Sections 8 and 12 of the Securities Regulation Code (SRC).

Consequently, those who act as salesmen, brokers, dealers or agents of **UNITYNET CORPORATION** in selling or convincing people to invest in the investment scheme being offered by **UNITYNET CORPORATION** including solicitations or recruitment through the internet may likewise be prosecuted and held criminally liable under Section 28 of the Securities Regulation

Code and penalized with a maximum fine of Five Million pesos (P5,000,000.00) or penalty of Twenty One (21) years imprisonment or both pursuant to Section 73 of the SRC.

Accordingly, those who invite or recruit other people to join or invest in this venture or offer contracts or securities to the public may be held liable or accordingly sanctioned or penalized in accordance with the Supreme Court decision in the case of SEC vs. Oudine Santos (G.R. No. 195542, March 19, 2014).

In view thereof, the public is hereby advised to exercise caution before investing in these kinds of activities and to take the necessary precaution in dealing with UNITYNET CORPORATION or its representatives.
