



BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE

RECOMMENDING AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE REGULATORY IMPACT ASSESSMENT FOR JUNIOR STAFF-1 BATCH

(Resolution No. 2022-144)

WHEREAS, Purchase Request No. 202201025 (Annex A) was received on 16 September 2022 for the Learning Service Provider for the Conduct of Program for the FY 2022-Regulatory Impact Assessment for Junior Staff-1 Batch with approved budget for the contract in the amount of **TWO HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND PESOS (Php 240,000.00)**;

WHEREAS, on October 06, 2022 the BAC forwarded to DAP Development Academy of the Philippines the letter requesting submission of its price offer and the following requirements for the Agency-to-Agency Procurement:

1. Certification that it owns or has access to the necessary tool and equipment required for the project; and
2. Certification that it has the mandate to deliver the goods and services required to be procured by SEC.

WHEREAS, on October 14, 2022, the End-user Department in its memorandum addressed to the BAC, submitted the following documents;

- a. Justification that entering into an Agency-to-Agency Agreements with the Servicing Agency is more efficient and economical to the government;
- b. Certification by the Head of Servicing Agency that:
 - b.1 It has the mandate to deliver the goods and services required to be procured or to undertake the Infrastructure project or consultancy required by the Procuring Entity;
 - b.2 It has the absorptive capacity to undertake the project; and
 - b.3 It owns and has access to the necessary tools and equipment required for the project

WHEREAS, consistent with the provisions under Section V. Specific Guidelines of Annex "H" Consolidates Guidelines for the Alternative Methods of Procurement of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 9184, and based on the assessment and recommendation of the end-user, the BAC found that the conditions for the Negotiated Procurement - Agency-to-Agency Agreement were satisfied;

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2022, Development Academy of the Philippines submitted the above mentioned requirements and its offer of Two Hundred Forty Thousand Pesos (Php 240,000.00).


WHEREAS, the offer of Development Academy of the Philippines is within the ABC and was found compliant with the Terms of Reference for the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby resolve to award the proposal of Development Academy of the Philippines in the amount of Two Hundred Forty Thousand Pesos (**₱240,000.00**) through Negotiated Procurement - Agency-to-Agency Agreement for the Learning Service Provider for the Conduct of Program for the FY 2022-Regulatory Impact Assessment for Junior Staff-1 Batch and to recommend to the Head of the Procuring Entity the award of contract to the same contractor/bidder in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Request for Proposal and accepted quotation.
